[Harrisonburg Public Bus Transportation - Fixed Route](#) (540.432.0492)

- Public bus system with wheelchair lifts, low floor buses, and voice announcements. [Reduced fares](#) are offered to senior citizens over 62 years of age

[Harrisonburg Paratransit](#) (540-432-0492)

- Curb-to-curb, shared ride public transportation service within the City of Harrisonburg for people whose disability prevents them from riding Fixed Route buses some or all of the time. Certification required. Call in advance.

Rockingham County Department of Social Services (540.432.8646)

- Transports legal US citizens age 60+ to medical appts and essential services for life's maintenance such as grocery stores, banks or drug stores when there is absolutely no other means of transport.

- In limited areas VPAS can provide transportation to medical appointments, grocery store, pharmacy, and bank when no other transportation options are available. Pre-registration and advance scheduling required.
